

Access to Forth Canoe Club Boathouse

We want everyone to be able to paddle as much as possible – but at the same time we have to remember that there is a lot of club and personal equipment in the boat house and we have suffered 2 break ins in recent times, so security is an issue for all club members to take seriously. The following are guidelines for using the boathouse.

There are 2 padlocks on the gate by the road – this key opens one of the padlocks – take off the padlock, open the gate and lock it behind you.

The same key will open the front door of the boathouse – once in the boathouse turn right into the mens changing rooms and turn off the alarm – the alarm number is XXXXX – please do not disclose this to anyone.

If you are paddling away from the boat house then please make sure that you lock all the doors – including the sliding door –

When you leave make sure you do the following:

1. Bolt the sliding door and corridor door
2. Turn off lights / heater
3. Re-set the alarm – again just type in XXXXX
4. Lock the door to the Boat House
5. Lock the gate onto the road
 - If the alarm goes off then you can re-set it by re-keying the alarm number

Fees

Each year you must pay a fee to hire a key for the canoe club – the rates are on the club website.
